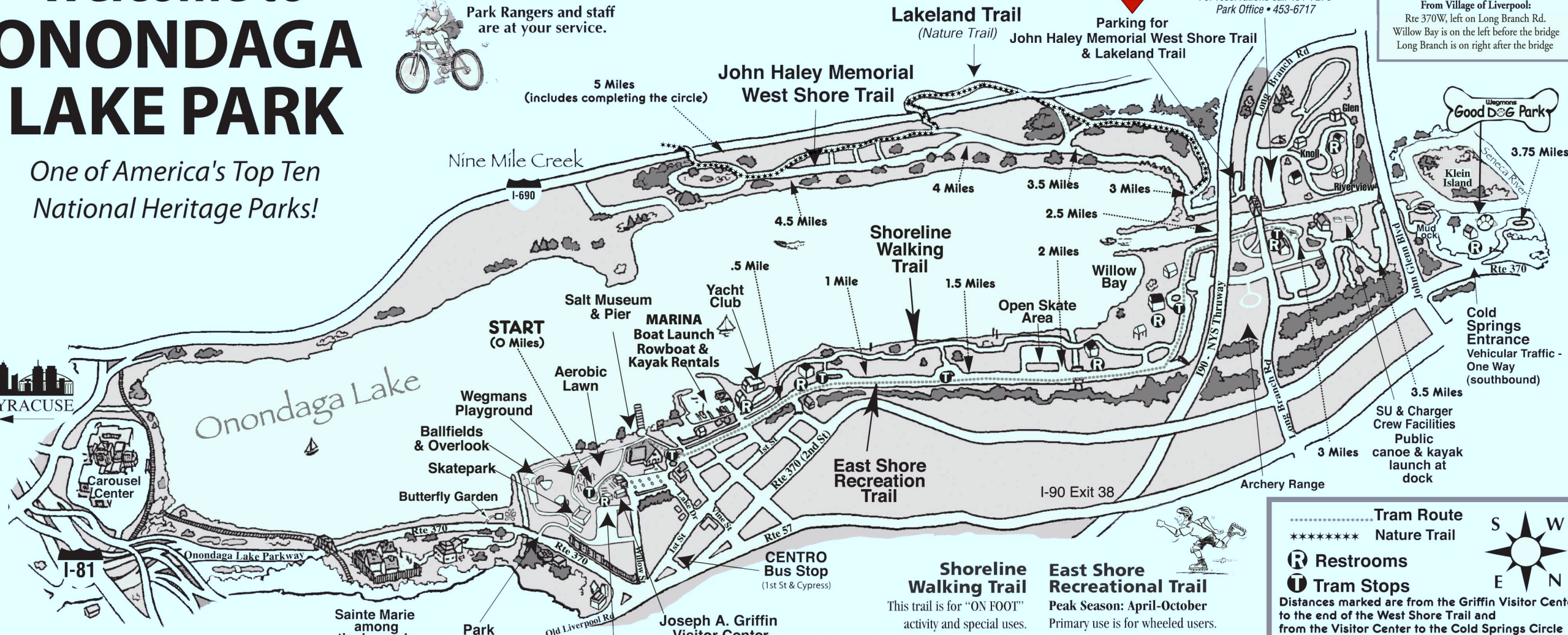

General Trail Rules

No motorized scooters/vehicles allowed • Keep to the right.
 Maintain safe, controllable speed • Wear proper safety equipment.
 Announce "passing" or "on your left" when passing.
 Be courteous to other users • Report all accidents to Park staff.
 Onondaga County law requires helmet use for ages 17 & below on bikes and in-line skates.

Shoreline Walking Trail
 This trail is for "ON FOOT" activity and special uses.
 No wheels are allowed except for wheelchairs, strollers, tricycles & training wheels.
 Dogs must be on a six foot leash.
 This trail is not plowed in the winter.
 When it snows, please use the plowed East Shore Recreation Trail.

East Shore Recreational Trail
Peak Season: April-October
 Primary use is for wheeled users.
 Pedestrian use is allowed only if it does not impede wheeled users.
 No more than two abreast and stay within three feet of shoulder.
 No dogs allowed.
 Trams follow the center line.
Off Season: November-March
 Wheels & pedestrians share the trail.
 Dogs on 6' ft leashes are allowed with pedestrians but not with wheeled users.
 No motorized vehicles allowed.
